Water service is set to be shut off on May 10, 2022 for non-payment of the March bill. If you are unable to pay your bill by that date, please be sure to submit a Request for Payment Plan form at least 48 hours prior. The form can be found at https://tinyurl.com/escwaterdisc.

If you need assistance paying down any remaining water debt, you may be eligible for other State or Federal assistance programs. One of those programs is the Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP), which will be administered through the California Department of Community Services and Development (CSD), and is scheduled to begin May 2022. STORM WATER CORNER

Residential water runoff from rain, hosing down driveways/ sidewalks, and sprinkler overwatering collects oil, gas, pet waste, heavy metals, fertilizers, leaves, and grass clippings on its way down the gutter to the storm drain. These materials enter local creeks and rivers untreated and become pollutants that negatively affect water quality. Sweep driveways and sidewalks instead of hosing down. Adjust sprinkler timers so that water does not leave the property. Public Works has labeled all City storm drain inlets with a circular label stating "Only Rain Down the Storm Drain". If you notice a missing label, or see

anyone illegally dumping into a storm drain, please contact the City Stormwater Line at 691-7495. ■
