#### **STORM WATER CORNER**

Residential water runoff from rain, hosing down driveways/ sidewalks, and sprinkler overwatering collects oil, gas, pet waste, heavy metals, fertilizers, leaves, and grass clippings on its way down the gutter to the storm drain. These materials enter local creeks and rivers untreated and become pollutants that negatively affect water quality. Sweep driveways and sidewalks instead of hosing down. Adjust sprinkler timers so that water does not leave the property. Public Works has labeled all City storm drain inlets with a circular label stating "Only Rain Down the Storm Drain". If you notice a missing label, or see

anyone illegally dumping into a storm drain, please contact the City Stormwater Line at 691-7495. ■
